In 1961, Yuri Gagarin became the first person to fly into space. Valentina Tereshkova was the first woman; she flew in 1963.

Up to the start of World Space Week 2021, a total of 69 women had flown in space. They include Helen Sharman, who became Britain's first astronaut in 1991. The latest launched on October 5.
