## 2023 Conference - Programme Outline

The theme for the 20th Reinventing Space conference is:

## The Evolving Architecture of New Space

The Conference will focus on the key benefits and emerging issues presented by the increasing use of space in the coming decades. As the number of active satellites in Earth orbit increases, the opportunities for interaction between different constellations are enhanced. Intersatellite links and roaming technologies should deliver improvements in a range of performance metrics, including satellite-to-satellite cueing, data fusion, data latency, and overall system capacity.

- Will new, cheaper launch vehicles and on-orbit servicing add to the pressure?
- Will the huge number of satellites increase the risk of collisions and further restrict astronomical observations?
- Can New-Space companies provide the answers?

## The 20<sup>th</sup> Reinventing Space conference and exhibition will be held at Spaces at The Spine in Liverpool from Wednesday 11 to Friday 13 October 2023

This year's conference runs across three consecutive days, with the option to attend any or all days. Each day will consist of a combination of talks from selected presenters as well as dedicated panel sessions and invited Keynote talks aligned with each day's theme:

- **Days 1 & 2** Wednesday to Thursday 11 12 October: Space exploration, infrastructure development, novel technologies, satellite servicing and recycling, in-situ resource utilisation, power, propulsion, and communications
- **Day 3** Friday 13 October: Day 3 marks 'BIS at 90', celebrating a proud heritage and looking to the future development and exploration of cis-lunar space, critical challenges and opportunities for human exploration of space 'Beyond the Moon' The conference will conclude on the Friday with the Gala Dinner which will include the Sir Arthur Clarke Awards.

## **Reinventing Space 2023 Comes to Liverpool**


The British Interplanetary Society returns to the place where it was founded 90 years ago in 1933 - **Liverpool**.

The conference will conclude on the Friday, with the Gala Dinner in the evening (optional), which will include the Sir Arthur Clarke Awards. This prestigious awards ceremony

recognises and rewards teams and individuals who have made significant achievements in, and contributions to, all space activities in 2022.

## The Spine, Liverpool



The Spine, a brand new £35m fourteen-storey, 160,000 ft² office building at the heart of Paddington Central, is not only one of the first in the UK to achieve a Platinum WELL Standard Certification but also one of the most intelligent, showcasing 'best-in-class' building connectivity. Taking its name from the striking staircase on its north elevation that resembles human vertebrae, the Spine has conference and events spaces available for private or commercial hire and boasts internal biophilia, including sky gardens,







#### $50^{\text{th}}$ anniversary of Project Daedalus

Project Daedalus was a study conducted between 1973 and 1978 by the British Interplanetary Society, to demonstrate the engineering feasibility of interstellar travel. Intended mainly as a scientific probe, the design criteria specified that the spacecraft had to use existing or near-future technology and had to be able to reach its destination within a human lifetime. Requiring assembly and fuelling in space, the cover artwork shows the scale of the Daedalus vehicle against the Saturn V Moon Rocket.
