The Golovine Lecture Hall

The Golovine Lecture Hall is recently refurbished and situated on the ground floor.

The room has built-in AV and video recording, with ceiling mounted projector, retractable screen and adjustable lighting levels. Also has fixed seating at back and left side of the room.

Comes with free usage of water cooler situated in Technology and Concepts Annex.

This space can be booked with the adjacent Technology and Concepts Annex for food service space, break out, or intimate dining option, and can be used for lectures, small exhibitions and press conferences, or product launches.

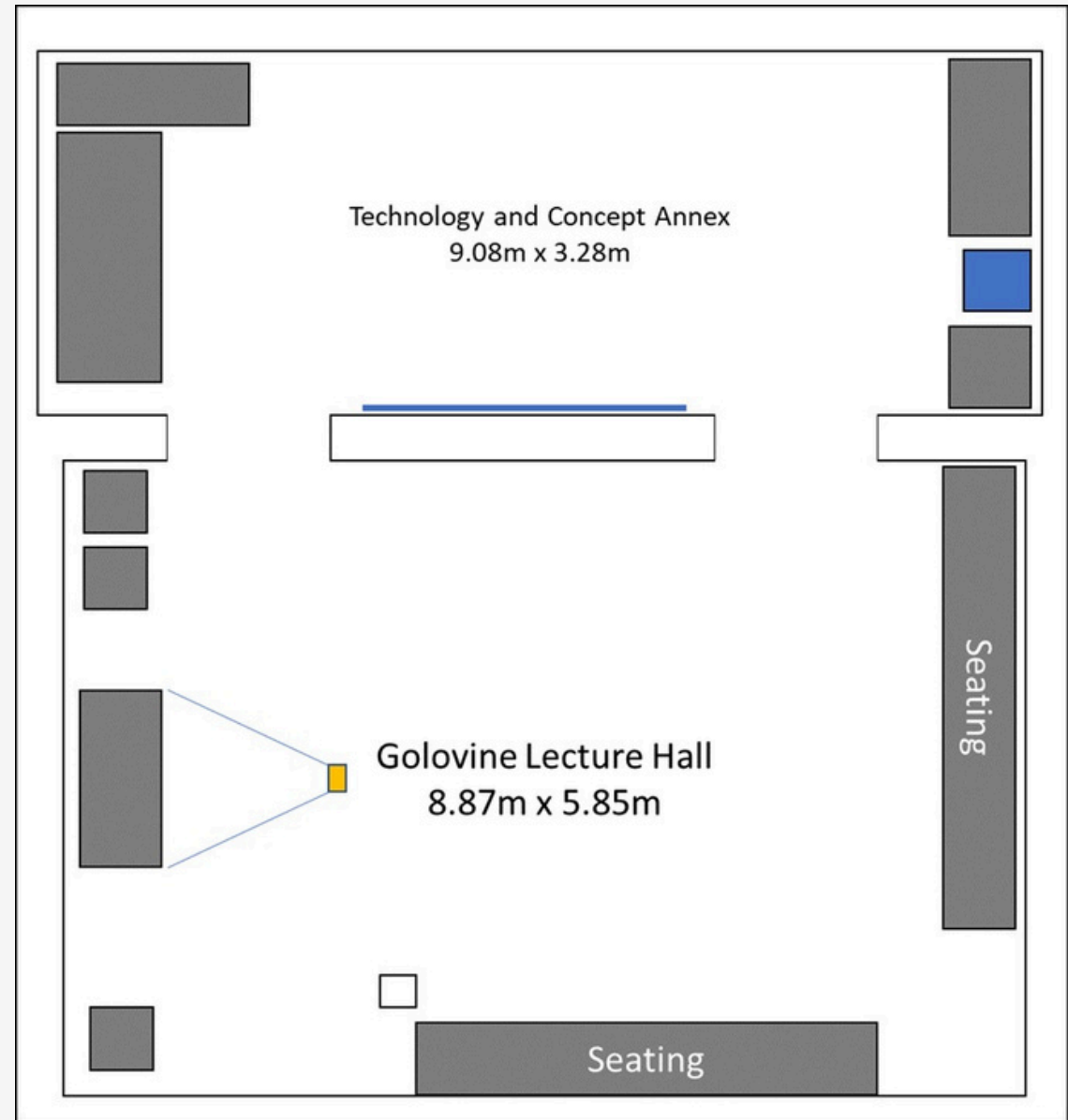

The Technology and Concepts Annex is decorated with artefacts, concept models and pictures of space related endeavours.

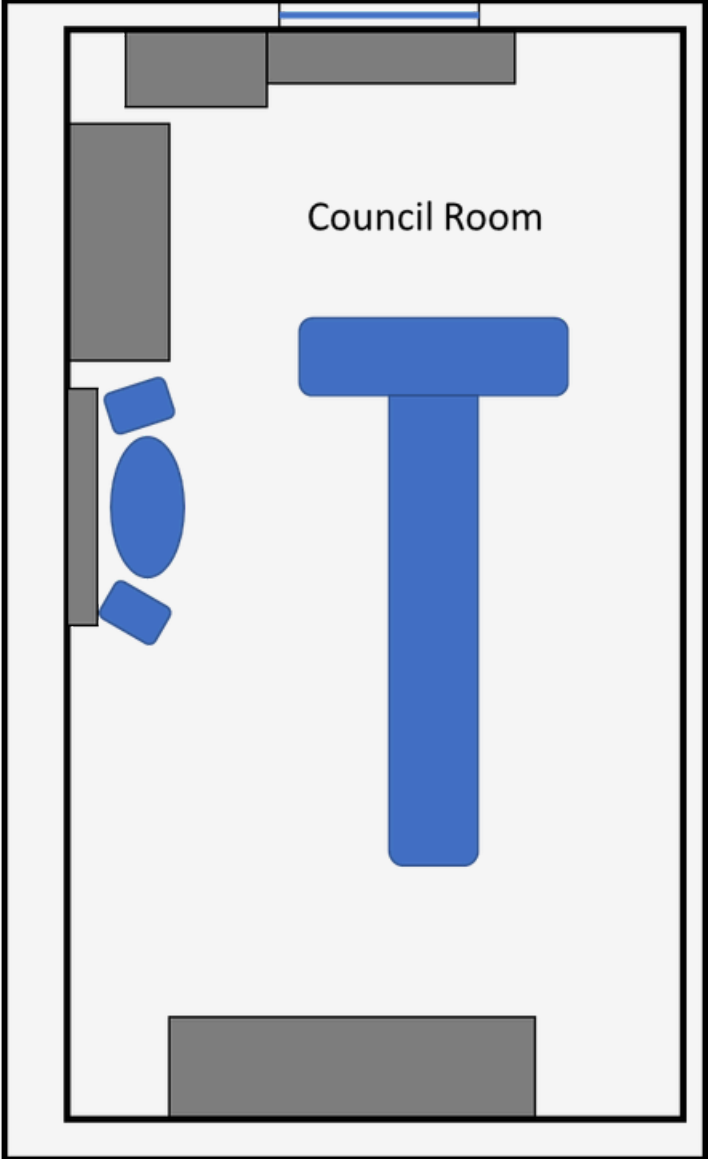

The Council Room is a prestige board room decorated with aspects of the BIS art, Lambeth Pottery and furniture collections, situated on the top floor.

The Council Room is on the second floor, and benefits from the privacy of being away from the main traffic areas of the building, allowing for meetings and discussions to happen uninterrupted from outside disturbances.

All Council Room bookings come with complementary use of a 40" LCD screen with HDMI connection; free dedicated Wi-Fi; and a Nespresso Vertuo Coffee machine, tea and bottled still water.

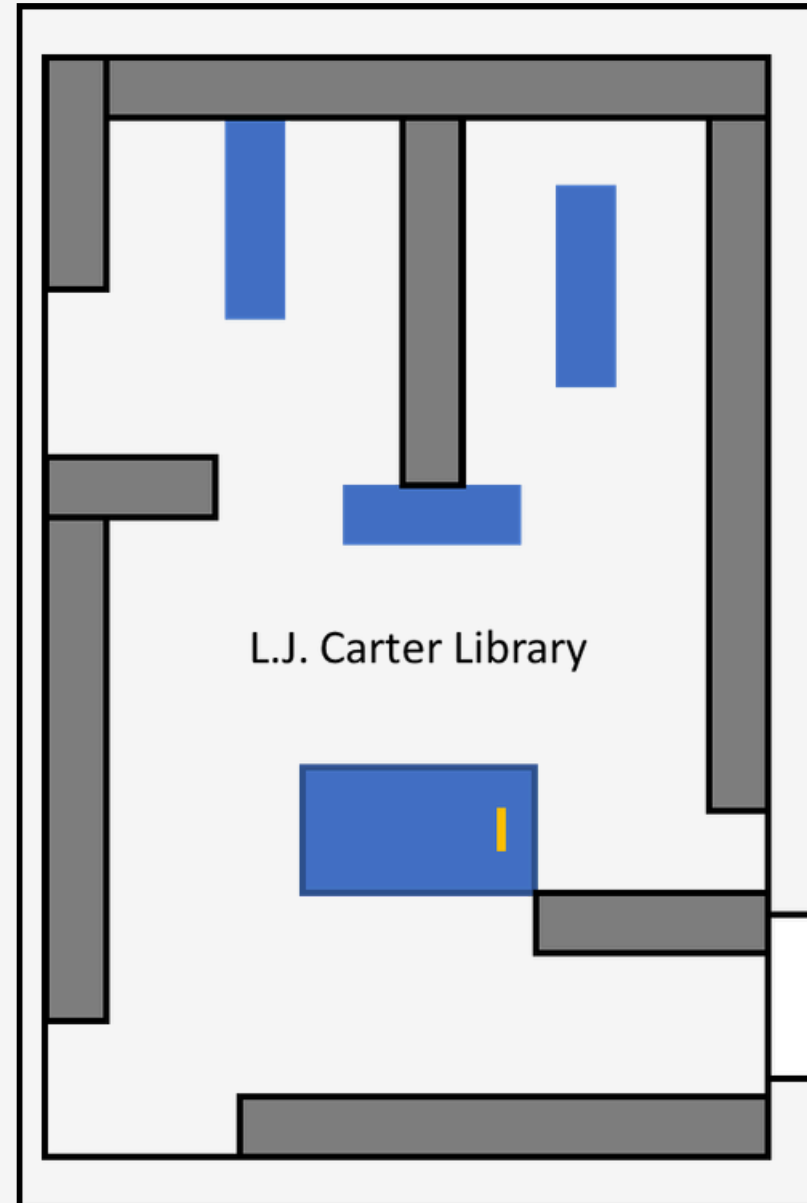

The L.J. Carter Library is the home to an extensive collection of reference and research archives related to space exploration and the history of the Society, dating back to the founding of the BIS in 1933. This unique and historic collection tells the story of space travel and academic research into astronautics, and contains key papers from space agencies around the world.

The Library has been used previously as a filming venue and offers a backdrop that enhances any production. It can also be used for talks, and breakout and small seminar groups.

The Lobby



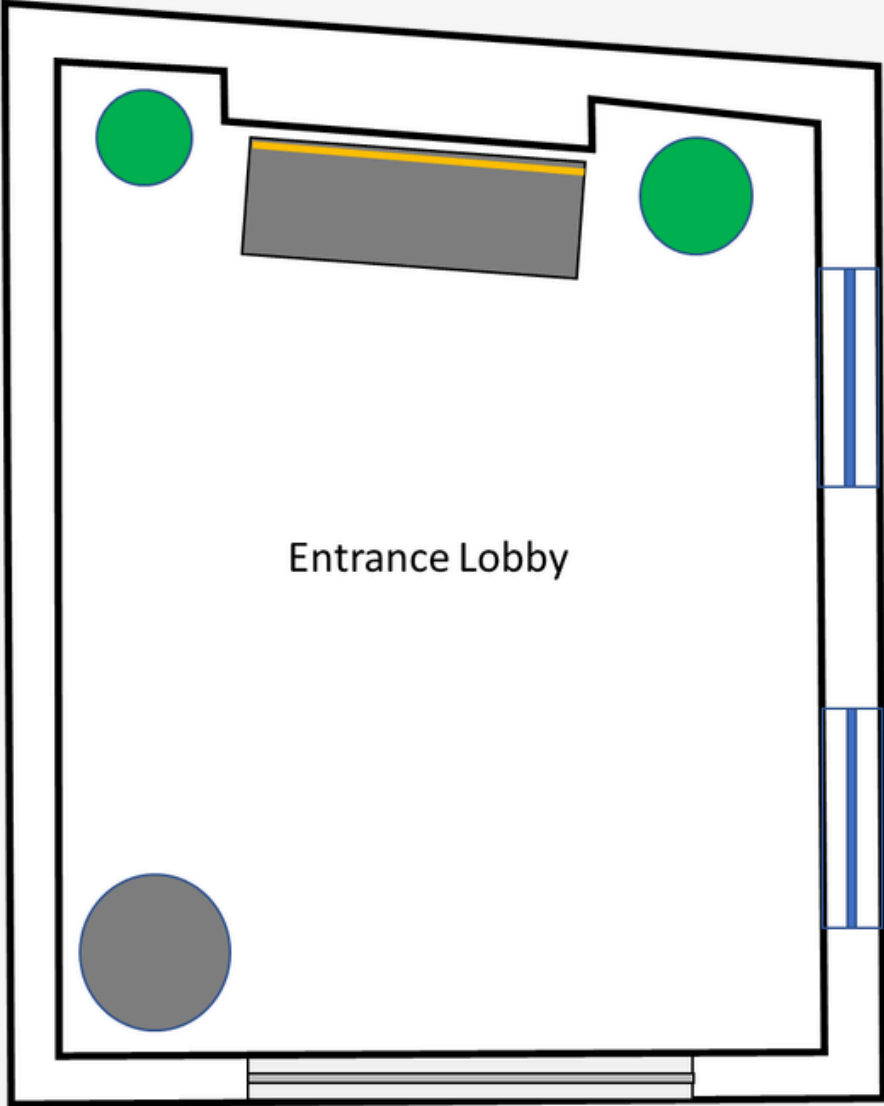
